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I . SAFETY GUIDELINES

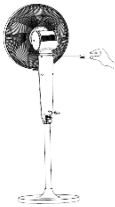
- 1. This appliance is suitable for children 8 and older and those with reduced abilities if supervised or instructed on safe use and potential hazards.

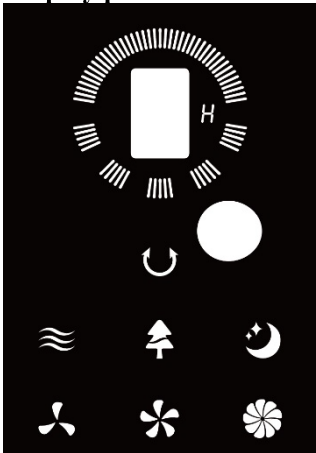

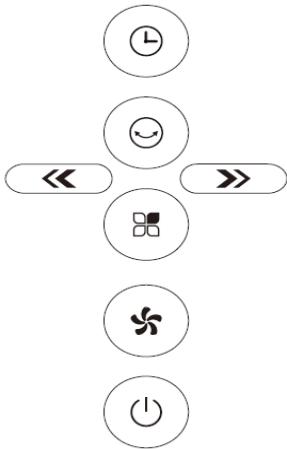

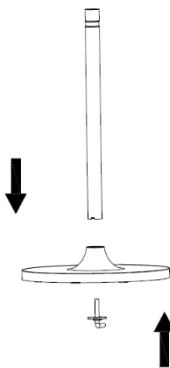


IV. INSTALLATION&OPERATING INSTRUCTION

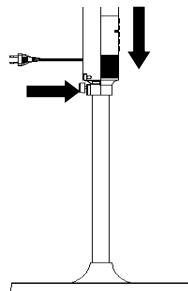
● Installation

1. Take out all parts and check if the manual, remote control, and spare parts are included.
2. Insert the column through the base hole and secure it tightly with a screw. (Figure 1)
3. Place the fan body onto the column and fix it with a nut. (Figure 2)
4. Attach the rear grill to the motor's rear cover, align it with the holes, and secure it with the grill nut. (Figure 3)
5. Mount the fan blade onto the motor axis and tighten it with the blade screw. (Figure 4)
6. Attach the front grill and grill ring to the rear grill, then secure the grill ring using the bottom lock. (Figure 5)
7. Once assembled, plug in the power and operate the fan as instructed in the manual.

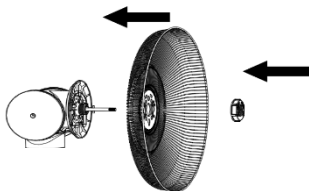

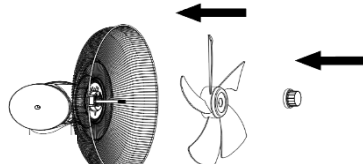

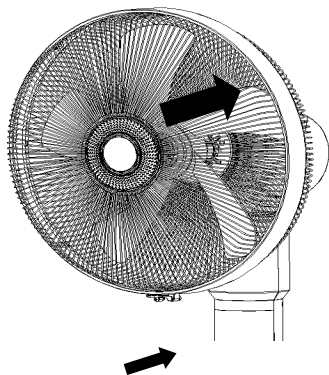

● OPERATION INSTRUCTION

All functions can be controlled by pressing the buttons on the control panel.

1. ON/ OFF

When first plugged in, the fan will emit a “Bi Bi” sound alert and enter standby mode, where only the “ON/OFF” button is functional.

2. SPEED

Press the “SPEED” button to adjust the wind speed in the sequence of L → M → H → L, with the LED light changing accordingly.

3. SWING

- a Manual Vertical Oscillation: Adjust manually to -8°, 0°, 10°, 20°, 30°, 40°, 50°, 60°, 70°, 80°, or 90° as needed.
- b Manual Horizontal Oscillation: Adjust freely by hand to any angle between 0° and 360°.
- c Automatic Horizontal Oscillation: Press the “SWING” button to cycle through oscillation settings in the sequence: 0° (stop) → 60° → 90° → 180° → 360° → 0° (stop)..., with the LED light changing accordingly.
- d Manual Swing Adjustment: Press and hold the button.  or  to move the fan head left or right. Release the button to stop the movement.

4. MODE

The fan starts in Normal Mode when turned on. Press the MODE button to cycle through: Normal → Nature → Sleeping → Normal..., with the display updating accordingly.

①. Normal Wind Mode

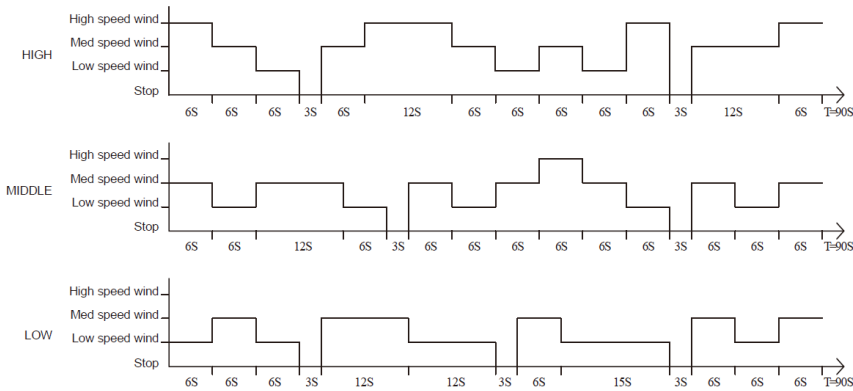
High Wind Speed: High -----

Medium Wind Speed: Medium ----

Low Wind Speed: Low ----

②. Natural wind

Natural Wind Mode includes three wind speeds: High, Medium, and Low, with airflow varying in a waveform pattern as shown in the following illustration.



③. Sleeping wind:

High: 30 minutes of high natural wind → 30 minutes of medium natural wind → Then maintains low natural wind.

Medium: 30 minutes' medium natural wind—low natural wind (keeping)

Low Natural Wind Mode: The fan operates at a low natural wind speed.

In Natural and Sleeping modes, the speed LED display does not change according to wind speed.

5. TIMER

After turning on, the fan has no default timer setting, and the TIMER LED is off. Press the TIMER button to set the running time in the sequence: 1H → 2H → 4H → 8H → No Timer → 1H..., with the LED light changing accordingly.

Once set, the system begins the countdown and runs until the unit turns off.

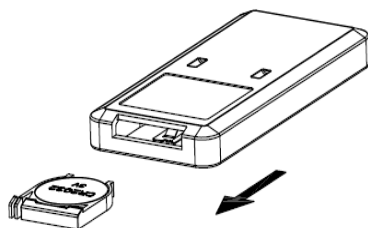
6. FUNCTION CONSERVATION

In standby mode, the fan retains the wind speed and oscillation settings. However, timer and sleeping mode settings will not be saved.

7. The LED light dim to 33% if no buttons are pressed for 1 minute. Pressing any button will restore the original brightness.

● Usage for remote control:

1. Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control and insert one CR2032 3V button battery.
2. Point the remote control towards the receiver; it may not work if obstructed. Handle the remote with care—avoid dropping it and store it in the handle.
3. Replace the battery only after turning off the power. Ensure correct positive (+) and negative (-) polarity when inserting the new battery.



V. CLEAN & MAINTAIN

- If excessive dust or dirt accumulates on the back grill cover, it may reduce airflow performance. We recommend cleaning the fan at least once per month for optimal performance.
The fan should be cleaned at least every two months.
 1. Always unplug the fan before cleaning.
 2. Wipe all parts with a soft cloth. Do not use gasoline, thinner, benzene as cleaning agents.
- Unit surface cleaning
 1. Do not allow water or steam to drip onto the fan.
 2. Do not use corrosive detergents or solvent-based cleaners.
 3. Always unplug the fan before cleaning.

- Product storage:

1. Unplug the fan and pack it properly to prevent dust from entering if not in use for a long time.
2. Store the packed fan in a dry, well-ventilated place.

VI.MAINTAIN GUIDANCE

If the fan stops rotating or emits an abnormal smell, immediately turn off the power and contact the company service center for repair.

Bhd. Zenne does not provide standard warranty for any purchases made from any online platform and or unauthorised dealers.
2. This warranty covers manufacturing defects or failures to normal usage within the specified warranty period. Zenne Infinity Sdn. Bhd. or its authorised service dealers, will at its discretion either repair or replace the defective parts of the product without charge. All replacement parts under this warranty shall become the property of Zenne Infinity Sdn. Bhd.
3. This warranty card is not replaceable if it is lost or misplaced.
4. Faulty Fan can be sent to Zenne Infinity Sdn. Bhd. or its authorised dealers for repair. Consumers will be responsible for any transportation costs associated with any necessary repair services conducted at the consumer's premise.
